**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW PORT RICHEY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 10 OF THE NEW PORT RICHEY CODE OF ORDINANCES, PERTAINING TO SOLID WASTE COLLECTION; PROVIDING CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FEE; PROVIDING FOR COLLECTION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR A LIEN FOR NON-PAYMENT OF THE FEE; PROVIDING FOR ADMINISTRATION BY THE CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING MISCELLANEOUS REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITION OF TERMS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

1. Summary of the proposed ordinance. The proposed ordinance serves the public health, safety, morals and welfare, and provides: Enhancements and improvements to the City's solid waste collection system, improved aesthetics to properties, improved efficiencies in collection of solid waste, opportunities for adjustments on a per property basis, relief for undeveloped properties, additional removal options for yard waste, opportunities to interrupt service when not needed, and collection options for small businesses and small multifamily properties.
