

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-39

RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW PORT RICHEY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PASCO COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, Florida Administrative Rule 9G-6 establishes the criteria for review of local emergency management plans; and

WHEREAS, the "Local Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan Compliance Criteria" which is adopted by reference in Rule 9G-6, sets forth the criteria and format for local emergency management plans; and

WHEREAS, Section 252.38(2), Florida Statutes, provides that "Municipalities are authorized and encouraged to create municipal emergency management programs"; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Port Richey has created a municipal emergency management program in compliance with all laws, rules, and requirements applicable to county emergency management programs; and


WHEREAS, the Pasco County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan has been reviewed by the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management, and declared to be in compliance with the terms of Chapter 9G-6; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Port Richey wishes to approve the county emergency management program, so long as the same does not supersede the City's adopted emergency management program.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of New Port Richey, a Florida municipal corporation, through its City Council, in regular session assembled this date, does hereby declare that the Pasco County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan is hereby approved and authorized to be activated by the City of New Port Richey. Nothing contained herein shall be deemed to supersede the provisions of the City's adopted municipal emergency management program.
