The City of New Port Richey is currently seeking proposals for RFP24-020 Construction Management Services for the City of New Port Richey Railroad Square Improvement Project. Sealed proposals addressed to the City of New Port Richey, City Clerk's Office, 5919 Main Street, New Port Richey, FL 34652, will be received at the City Clerk's Office until 2:00 p.m. Friday, July 26th, 2024. Any proposals received after the time and date specified will not be considered.

Sealed envelopes or packages containing seven (7) copies and one electronic copy as a single PDF file on a flash drive of the Proposal Forms. The outside of the envelope must be clearly marked with the proposer's name and full address along with "RFP24-020 CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF NEW PORT RICHEY RAILROAD SQUARE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT." Proposals shall be submitted in the form and manner contained in the Proposal Requirements.

A mandatory pre-proposal meeting will be held at the project site, 5751 Nebraska Ave, New Port Richey, FL 34668 on Wednesday, June 26th, 2024 at 10:00 AM. Attendance is mandatory for all proposers; this will be the only opportunity for proposers to examine existing conditions where construction will be taking place.

No proposal will be considered unless the proposer shall furnish evidence satisfactory to the City that the proposer has the necessary facilities, abilities, experience, equipment, financial and physical resources available to fulfill the conditions of the Contract and execute the work, should the Contract be awarded such proposer. Proposers will examine the information provided and the location in which said work is to be done and judge for themselves all the circumstances and surrounding known and reasonably foreseen conditions affecting the cost and nature of the work, and all proposals will be presumed to be based on such examination, familiarity and judgment.

The successful proposer will be required to comply with the provisions of all State of Florida and federal laws concerning public works projects. The City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, and to waive any technicalities and irregularities in the proposals and to hold the proposal proposals for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of opening set forth above.
